This position is located at the Pueblo of Isleta Natural Resources Division, and responds to environmental emergencies including hazardous fuels reduction, wildland fire control and burned area emergency rehabilitation. Conducts natural resource management projects; such as forest and riparian woodland/bosque restoration and special projects for the Natural Resources Department and other Pueblo of Isleta departments as needed.

**Minimum Qualifications/Requirements:**

- High School Diploma or GED.
- Experience in forestry and/or fire operations preferred.
- Wildland Red Card Certification preferred.
- Hazmat Operations Certification preferred.
- First Aid and CPR Certification.
- Must be able to pass a physical examination.
- Must pass the "Arduous Level" work capacity "Pack Test" within 90 days of employment.

**Knowledge, Skill and Ability Requirements: Describe how you obtained these Knowledge, Skills and Abilities**

- Knowledge of fire behavior and fire suppression principles, methods, techniques and practices.
- Skill in making effective decisions in emergency situations.
- Ability to safely operate tools, apparatus, vehicles and equipment used in fire suppression, rescue and medical assistance operations.
- Ability to use chainsaws, skid-steer, mulchers and chippers.
- Ability to work in the outdoors in extreme weather conditions.
- Ability to work various schedules and extended hours.
- Ability to work independently and meet strict time lines.
- Ability to analyze situations and adopt appropriate courses of action.

Physical Demands:

- Operates a variety of machinery, tools and equipment which includes a motor vehicle, computer, generator, fire pump, fire hydrant, axe, shovel, hydraulic tools, power tools, hand tools, medical equipment, etc.
- Must be able to move or carry objects or materials in excess of 100 lbs. of force occasionally, and/or in excess of 50 lbs. of force frequently.

Other Requirements:

Individual selected is subject to the following:
